

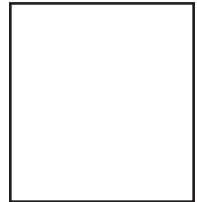

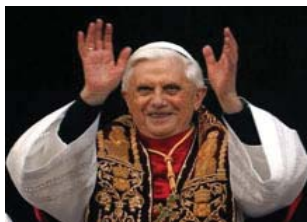

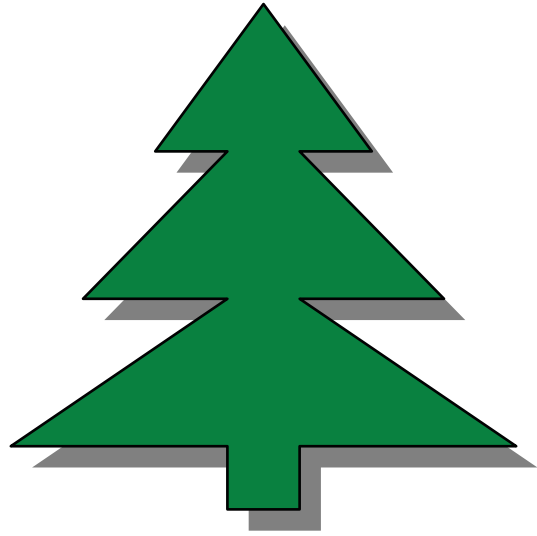
Re: Lapel Pins

Date: September 6, 2011

We are still receiving calls and emails regarding the issue of pins. Obviously some members do not understand our policy on the wearing of Fourth Degree pins.

Please advise your District Masters to instruct all Faithful Navigators and Color Corps Commanders of the following:

1. The only pin worn on the lapel by members while in official regalia dress is the official pin of the Fourth Degree, which is available from the Knights of Columbus supreme Supply Department – item PG-113. (Refer to pg.11 of the Color Corps Drill Manual)
2. Color Corps members may wear the National Flag Pin of their respective country in lieu of wearing the official Fourth Degree pin. However, all members of the Color Corps must wear the same identical pin or no pin at all shall be worn.
3. Under no circumstance is a member of the Color Corps to wear a separate flag pin with the official Fourth Degree (PG-113) pin in regalia. If the wearing of a flag pin is chosen then only one pin, the National Flag Pin is authorized.
